

- 2. **Mr. Fakrul Alam** (from Bangladesh): He is a Bangladeshi Academician, writer and translator. His literary works includes matters on postcolonial issues and translation of works of Rabindranath Tagore and Jibananda Das in English. His publications include *The Essential Tagore* (Harvard UP, 2011; with Radha Chakravarty); Imperial Entanglements and Literature in English (writer's ink: Dhaka, 2007) and many other publications. He also wrote "Unfinished Memoirs- a book on biography of Father of Nation of Bangladesh/ Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. He has been awarded Bangla Academy Literary Award.
- 3. **Prof. Dr. Bidyut Chakrabarty** (from India) present Vice Chancellor, Viswa Bharati University, Shantiniketan, INDIA. Recipient of many awards, he is a prolific writer with many books in his credit published by reputed publishers globally. Dr. Chakrabarty has just completed a full length monograph on Tagore's Social and Political ideas. Desh has just published long essay on the same theme in Bengali.
- 4. **Dr. Biswajit Ghosh** (from Bangladesh): present Vice Chancellor of Rabindra University Bangladesh is an essayist and researcher of repute. He has been awarded *Bangla Academy Literary Award & Ekushey Padak* for his contribution in research.
